While neither program is specifically called a graduate program in LD, both include courses and research opportunities in this area. One option is the Applied Master's in School Psychology, which is accredited by the International School Psychology Association (ISPA). This three-year program includes 1500 hours of practicum, and graduates can register as school psychologists in Cyprus or internationally (https://www.ucy.ac.cy/psych/magister-artium-in-school-psychology/?lang=en). The other program is the Doctorate in Psychology, which takes four years to complete.
